Essential Functions

- Utilizes GIS/GPS processes to develop spatial data as required for GIS project
- Develop, analyze, manipulate, extract and import GIS and CADD data
- Enters delineated map and descriptive information into the GIS through digitizing, key entry or other standard data entry procedures
- Investigates and verifies geographic and land use data by making physical inspections and/or surveys of real property assets
- Utilizes GIS/GPS technology to develop and produce maps, data, and reports

Desired Qualifications

- Bachelor's Degree in GIS, Geography or Civil Engineering or related physical or social science field
- GIS expert with great attention to detail, quality and accuracy
- At minimum, knowledge of ArcGIS (ArcMap, ArcCatalog, ArcToolbox, Collector, Survey123) is a requirement
- ESRI geodatabase experience
- Able to work independently with little direction and as a team player in a fast paced, challenging environment
